NSW GOVERNMENT NAMES NEW PIC INSPECTOR

The NSW Government today announced the appointment of The Hon David Levine AO RFD QC as the new Inspector of the Police Integrity Commission.

The Governor of NSW made the appointment this morning and Mr Levine's appointment will take effect from 1 February 2012 for a term of five years.

Mr Levine brings a wealth of experience to the role having served on the bench for nearly 20 years, including 13 years on the NSW Supreme Court.

In 2006-07, he also served as President of the Defence Force Board of Inquiry into a Black Hawk incident aboard HMAS Kanimbla which killed two personnel and injured seven.

Mr Levine has been the Chair of the Serious Offenders Review Council since August 2006.

The NSW Government thanks the outgoing PIC Inspector, Mr Peter Moss, for his service.

The appointment of Mr Levine as the new PIC Inspector follows the appointment on 1 January 2012 of the Hon. Bruce James QC as PIC Commissioner.
