

<u>Elrond Drive site update – December 2022</u>

The temporary accommodation village at Elrond Drive, Kingscliff has been leased to provide housing for local people who cannot return home because of flood damage.

This update is to provide you with more information about pod village management and welcoming new Elrond Drive residents.

Elrond Drive Village

Upcoming works

- Handover of the last seven units, community facilities and site office before the end of 2022.
- Minor works and landscaping to finalise the site.

New residents

- Many of the residents to Elrond Drive Village will begin moving into their new homes over the Christmas and New Year period.
- There may be an increase to local traffic, we appreciate your cooperation during this time.
- A community welcome event is being considered for the Kingscliff community to come and meet some of the new Village residents. This will be managed by the community housing provider, North Coast Community Housing. Keep an eye out for more details about a welcome event in the new year.

Site management

- The Elrond Drive Village has been handed over to North Coast Community Housing (NCCH) as the appointed Community Housing Provider.
- NCCH manage the site and support the allocation of residents to the housing units. NCCH will maintain an on-site presence with on-site security and case management.
- NCCH also works closely with local Recovery Support Services (RSS) to provide the required support for residents, including mental and physical health, financial support and supporting their transition to a more permanent living situation.

NCCH site management

- NCCH standard staffed hours are:
 - 8.30am 4.30pm for on-site management.
 - 4.30pm 8.30am for overnight security.


