

Construction hours update – January 2023

The temporary accommodation site at Prince & Station Street, Mullumbimby has been leased to host housing for local people who cannot return home because of flood damage.

This update is to provide you with more information about construction hours.

Construction hours

- To enable construction at the Prince & Station Street temporary housing site to be finished as quick as possible, NSW Reconstruction Authority (formerly Resilience NSW) (NSWRA) has sought to extend approved construction hours. Byron Shire Council has approved this request as the approving authority.
- Weekend works will be extended to **Saturday 8am to 4pm**.
- Additional Saturday afternoon works will include painting and decorating, plastering, electrical and plumbing work, joinery, gardening and other light trades.
- Extended weekend working hours are **effective as of Saturday 21 January 2023** and will continue until the site is completed in late February 2023.

What to expect

- Light power tool noise, dust and some paint fumes. We'll minimise this where we can.
- Increased site personnel during the extended working hours. Site personnel will utilise empty land adjacent to the site along Argyle and Prince Streets for parking to minimise congestion and roadside parking on Prince Street.
- No heavy machinery will be used.
