

<u>Construction update – October 2022</u>

Flood Recovery - Temporary accommodation sites 125 Tweed St, Brunswick Heads (behind the sports fields)

The temporary accommodation site at Tweed Street, Brunswick Heads been leased to host housing for local people who cannot return home because of flood damage.

This update is to provide you with more information about construction timeframes and expected works.

Construction hours

- Site works have commenced and in the last few weeks, you may have seen crews getting the sites ready, installing fencing, and stockpiling materials.
- To enable temporary housing sites to be established as quick as possible, Resilience NSW has sought to extend the
 approved construction hours at the Tweed Street site. Byron Shire Council has approved this request as the approving
 authority.
- Works will now occur seven days per week, from 7am to 10pm. We are working to minimise disruption to nearby
 residents, and where possible will schedule works likely to cause significant noise to Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and
 Saturday 8am to 1pm.
- The extended construction hours do not apply to the Excelsior Circuit and Torakina Road site which, when under construction, will carry out works between Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday from 8am to 1pm.

What to expect

- Nightwork with crews, trucks and safety lighting will be in place for all nightwork. Safety barriers will be in place to keep everyone safe.
- Noise, dust and reversing beepers from construction and machinery. We'll minimise this where we can.
- Traffic controllers will be on site where required to look after pedestrians and road users.
